## Important information to note

The Central Coast Acquisition Award for \$2,500 is, in the Judges' opinion, the best example in any medium in any subject exhibited. Council will acquire the work for display in the Council Foyer for 12 months. It will be hung later in other Central Coast public buildings as part of the Council's collection.

Ten categories will be judged professionally on the basis of artistic presentation merit. Prizes will be awarded to the winners of each category. The artist retains the work unless it is acquired by a sponsor or sold to someone attending the Exhibition.

Sponsors and supporters in addition to Central Coast Council have agreed to acquire one or more paintings of their choice. Commitments range up to \$1,000 but sponsors will pay more if the painting they select is priced above their sponsorship.

The MAXIMUM SIZE including frame is 1.22 metres (4 feet) on any side.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ENTRIES. Will not be accepted without a completed & signed entry form. Photocopies of the original Entry Form are acceptable. (NB the form can be printed from the website -see below). Each artist may enter up two works. Entries close Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October 2023. Late Entries will not be accepted.
- ONLINE REGISTRATION. Website: <a href="https://rotaryulverstonewest.org.au/artex">https://rotaryulverstonewest.org.au/artex</a>
   On home page select 'Entry Form', at bottom of 'ArtEx Entry Form' page, select 'Open Entry Form'. Complete the form then 'Submit'. Alternatively, under 'Open Entry Form' you can select 'Printable Version' of the entry form and complete manually. Then mail to: ArtEx, PO Box 100, Don 7310.
- ENTRY FEES. The entry fee is \$15 per entry. There are three methods of payment.

   (B) By cheque when posting your printed form
  - (C) Pay by cash or card when delivering your painting to the exhibition. Delivery of works will be Tuesday 7th November 2023
- 4. FRAMING. All work must be suitably framed, *including stitching / fabric work*, and should be wired for hanging. Artist's name and the artwork title is to be printed on back upper right-hand side. Please see diagram on the next page. Note: Clip frames are not acceptable.
- 5. MAXIMUM SIZE. Maximum size including frame is 1.22 metres or 4 feet on any side.



- ELIGIBLE WORKS. Artwork that has won an award (including Commended or Highly Commended)
  in any other exhibition is not eligible to be entered. Each work may be entered into one professionally
  judged category. Unless otherwise specified by the Artist, all paintings are considered eligible for the
  Central Cost Council Acquisition Award.
- EMERGING ARTIST AWARD. This category is open to all artists who have NEVER won an award or Commendation in any art exhibition or competition with any art piece. Please indicate this clearly on your registration form.
- . ARTIST'S OWN WORK. All work must be *original*, unaided work of the artist, having been completed in the last 12 months.
- OTHER CONDITIONS. The organisers reserve the right not to exhibit a painting, but space permitting, all entries will be hung.
- SELLING. All entered works must be For Sale, and may be reproduced by media or organisers for promotional purposes such as on the ArtEx / Rotary website.
- 11. COMMISSION. Commission will be charge at 25% on all paintings purchased by sponsors or the general public, excepting the Central Coast Council Acquisition Award where no commission applies. Artists are encouraged to allow for this when pricing their work.
- CENTRAL COAST COUNCIL ACQUISITION AWARD. Irrespective of the artist's pricing, the winner of this award will receive \$2,500 non-negotiable.
- 13. CATEGORIES. A work assigned to a single medium category may contain up to 20% additional medium. Works with more than 20% additional medium will be considered to be Mixed Media.
- 14. JUDGING. The judges and their decisions are independent of the North West Art Circle, Rotary Club of Ulverstone West Inc., Central Coast Council or Sponsors.
- 15. JUDGES' DISCRETION. At the judges' discretion, a painting may be awarded a prize in another category. Please note that Judges' decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- DELIVERY TIME. Strictly Tuesday, 7<sup>th</sup> November 2023 between 3 pm and 5:30 pm. Early delivery is not possible.
- 17. FREIGHTED WORKS. Works may be freighted to and from the exhibition. Return freight must be pre-arranged and prepaid, or included with the entry fee. Delivery Address for freighting is: Central Coast Council Chambers, 19 King Edward Street, Ulverstone 7315. Works are to arrive by Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2023 between 8:30 am and 5:00 pm. Only work delivered by a freight forwarder will be accepted. *Please advise (asap) Sandy Michell on 0407 825 430* if sending work by freight.
- 18. COLLECTION. Collection of art work is strictly between 3:30 5:30 pm on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> November 2023. Please do not ask to have work removed before this time. There are no facilities for storage either before or after the exhibition. Uncollected work will become the property of the Rotary Club Ulverstone West.

- INSURING ARTWORK. While every care will be taken, the organisers will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or theft of any artwork. Artists are encouraged to consider insuring artwork.
- 20. OPENING NIGHT. Opening night for the ArtEx exhibition is Friday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2023, 6:30pm for 7 pm. The exhibition is open to the public from Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> November until Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> November, from 10 am to 4 pm daily.
